The Center for New Data created novel data tools and analyses to support high-impact research, media, and policy reports, and to improve and clarify public understanding of pressing issues. Primary areas of focus were: (i) monitoring in-person voting times in the 2020 General Election to report disparities or gaps in access and (ii) measuring and mitigating COVID-19 superspreader risk.To support this work, the organization received contributions of licensed data, services, and compute resources of \$1.13 million-namely, licensed data with market value of \$827,917; of licensed software valued at \$124,698; and data storage and compute resources valued at \$177,423
