The Second Step fosters the safety, stability, and well-being of survivors of domestic violence.

Our residential and community-based programs build on the strengths, needs, and values of the individuals and families we serve. In partnership with survivors and in collaboration with the community, we lay a foundation for a future free from abuse and full of possibility.

Founded in 1992, The Second Step partners with survivors to address the aftermath of abuse and build brighter futures for themselves and their children. The Second Step also works to address the root causes of domestic violence and end it in our time.

We are pleased to share our **FY 2015 Annual Report** with you, highlighting The Second Step's accomplishments over the past year.

Your generosity and partnership have allowed us to envision and shape a stronger organization – one which over the past year alone has provided:

- Over 21,000 days and nights of safety and healing to the 58 parents and children who live in our Residential Programs.
- Individual advocacy, safety planning, physical and mental illness and post-traumatic stress disorder counseling, peer support groups, and assistance with job training and housing stabilization to 250 adult survivors in our Community Programs.
- Intense support to 60 children and teens in our many Youth Programs, which include a therapeutic after-school program, camps, one-on-one tutoring and mentoring, and ground-breaking groups for children and adolescents affected by violence.
- Free legal representation and services related to custody, restraining orders, housing, immigration, and other legal needs to 150 survivors through our Steps to Justice Programs.
- Outreach and education efforts to over 2,500 people in our community and beyond, to prevent the next generation of abuse.

We are excited and eager to build on this excellent work to ensure that The Second Step continues to provide the highest quality services to survivors, expands our reach to help more people, and collaborates with others for systems change. In this Annual Report, you will see the ways in which we have optimally positioned the organization for even greater impact going forward.

As The Second Step enters our 25th year of operation in 2016, we are ever thankful for the collaborative spirit and support of our donors and volunteers. 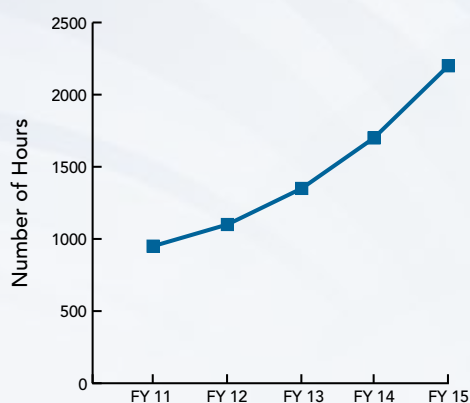

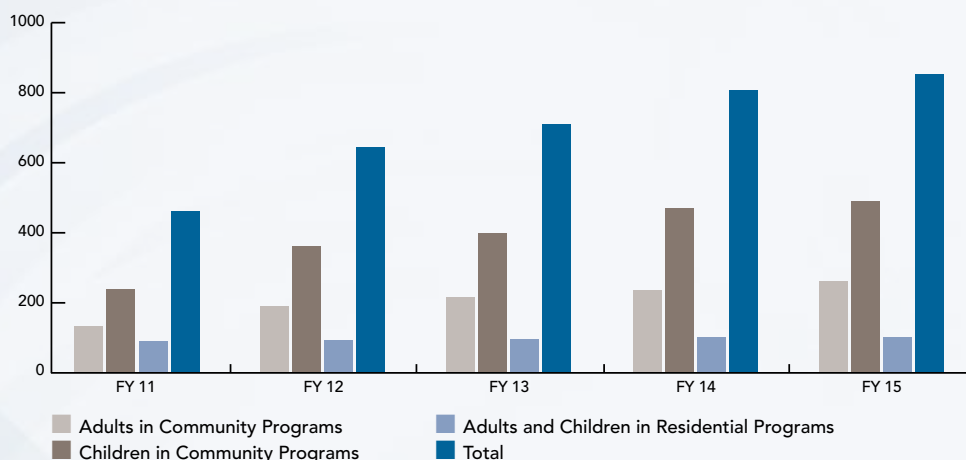

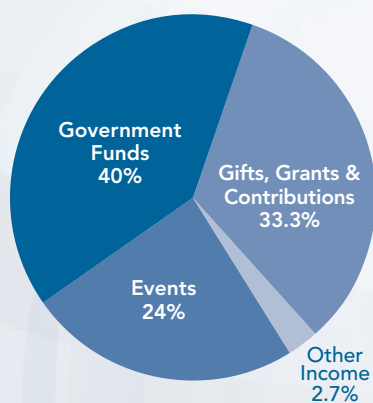

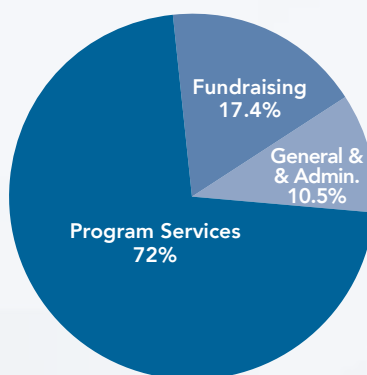

REVENUE FY 2015 \$1,866,440

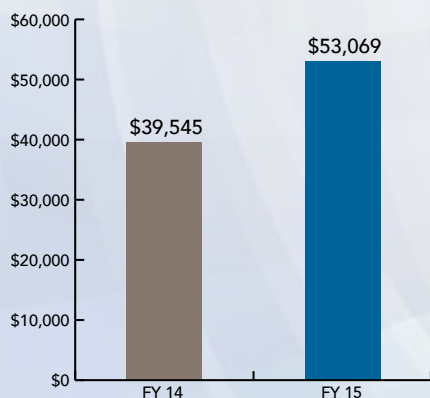


EXPENSES FY 2015 \$1,833,371

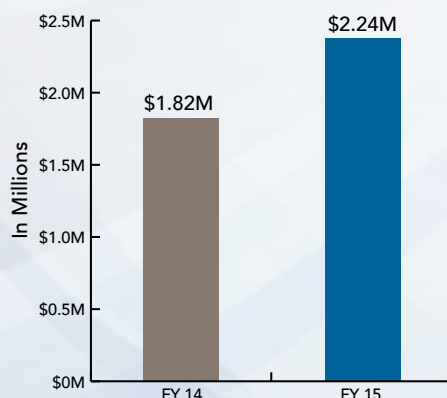


Net Revenue Over Expenses \$53,069

NET REVENUE OVER EXPENSES



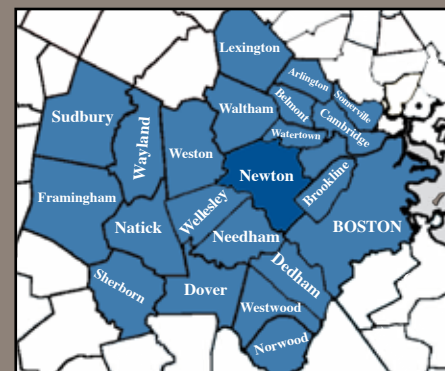
NET ASSETS (End of Year)

- Legal assistance with restraining orders, family law, landlord-tenant relations, and immigration issues
- Comprehensive services to address physical and mental illness, post-traumatic stress disorder, and substance abuse
- A transitional living program of two residences, which can jointly house seventeen families for up to two years
- A therapeutic afterschool program for elementary-age children living in our residences
- Peer support groups for survivors and their loved ones
- Child and adult individual mentoring programs
- Training in financial literacy, self-defense, parenting, nutrition, and other life skills
- Community outreach and education to raise awareness and prevent abuse
