THE FARMING AND GARDENING NONPROFIT NOW MANAGES 20 FARMS, COMMUNITY GARDENS, AND SCHOOL GARDENS THROUGHOUT MISSOULA, MONTANA'S URBAN CORE. ITS MISSION IS TO PLANT SEEDS AND GROW TOGETHER TO CREATE A HEALTHY MISSOULA, WHICH IS CARRIED OUT THROUGH FOUR PROGRAMS THAT IMPACT 20,000 COMMUNITY MEMBERS ANNUALLY.
