Description of Program Service One

Founded in 1887 the San Diego Center for Children is the community's oldest accredited nonprofit organization serving children, youth, and families. The Center began as the Women's Home Association, a residence for indigent, aged, and destitute women. In 1888, local businessmen, alarmed at the rate of absenteeism among female employees offered funds to establish the Day Care Nursery and the name changed to the Women and Children's Home. A contract with the County of San Diego provided funds to build a new structure; two years later the Women and Children's home moved to Balboa Park. A fire destroyed the Children's Industrial Home and its residents merged with the Women and Children's Home.

The City of San Diego exchanged the Balboa site for the current ten-acre Kearney Mesa site in 1957. The name was changed to the San Diego Center for Children in 1959 to better reflect the services being offered to the community.

Today, the Center offers a fully integrated program of therapeutic and educational services for children and youth who struggle with mental, emotional, and behavioral problems. The Center provides programs and services designed to strengthen the child and family in their home and community. We collaborate with educational and public health leaders to support and advance children's mental health at the county, state, and national levels. Our vision is to enrich the community by nurturing, strengthening, and empowering the family by providing proven and effective mental health, education, and social services.

We serve nearly 1,200 children and adolescents throughout San Diego County in our community-based programs from early intervention in preschools to mental health outpatient services for children in elementary through high schools.

The Center's onsite special education school and day treatment programs in the community provide mental health treatment in a school setting for about 125 young people.

Our residential, structured 24-hour treatment program for high risk children, therapeutic foster care for children, and respite services for foster families serve more than 300 children.

Building on a child's strengths, the Center's goal is to promote his/her successful transition to and stabilization in the most natural home, school, and community setting. Our approach is based on a set of values and a creative service approach that includes and supports the family. Our programs and services are designed to meet the unique needs of each child and family.
