WE ARE FOUNDED IN THREE FACETS: GRANT MAKING, LEADERSHIP

IN 2018 THE CENTER HOSTED MANY COMMUNITY EVENTS, INCLUDING PLAYS, MUSICAL PERFORMANCES AND ART SHOWS. WE ARE WORKING TO TRANSFORM THE OUTDOOR SPACE INTO A COMMUNITY GREEN SPACE FEATURING WALKWAYS, BENCHES AND AREAS FOR GROUPS TO GATHER, SCULPTURES, LANDSCAPING WITH NATIVE PLANTS. IT WILL BE A PLACE WHERE PEOPLE CAN MEET THEIR FRIENDS, ENJOY A PICNIC, LEARN ABOUT OUR AREA, OR JUST SIT AND BREATHE IN THE MOUNTAIN AIR. IN 2018, THERE WERE 108 DAYS OF USAGE BY 42 DIFFERENT GROUPS. THERE ARE 11 LONG TERM TENANTS. VOLUNTEERS PROVIDED 760 VOLUNTEER HOURS TO IMPROVE THE BUILDING. A NEW HEATING SYSTEM WAS INSTALLED ON THE 1920'S SIDE OF THE BUILDING. PARTNERED WITH THE CARBON COUNTY ARTS GUILD TO PROVIDE A SATELLITE GALLERY.

CARBON COUNTY CONNECT, AN ONLINE RESOURCE DIRECTORY, DISTRIBUTED 1,000 PRINTED COPIES ACROSS THE COUNTY TO SUPPORT THOSE IN POVERTY AND LOW INCOME SITUATIONS. WITH THE CLOSURE OF OUR LOCAL OFFICE OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE, WE TRAINED 12 VOLUNTEER NAVIGATORS TO SUPPORT PEOPLE IN FILLING OUT COMPLICATED RESOURCE APPLICATIONS. FURTHER DEVELOPED WORKFORCE HOUSING BY CREATING A LAND TRUST APPROACH THAT WILL KEEP THE HOMES AFFORDABLE WELL AFTER ITS FIRST FAMILY. WORKED ALONGSIDE THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO EARN AARP'S AGE FRIENDLY DESIGNATION, THE SECOND IN THE STATE OF MONTANA. PROVIDED SUICIDE PREVENTION TRAINING FOR 161 HIGH SCHOOL
