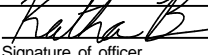

Community-based Domestic Violence Services: PADV provides an array of community based services for survivors who may not need shelter but do need assistance to escape a violent relationship and remain free of violence. Support groups are offered across Metro Atlanta and provide a safe place for women who have left violent relationships or continue to live with abusers to come together and share experiences, offer encouragement, support and generate ideas on ways to live violence free.
