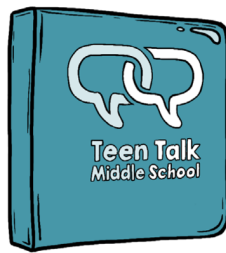

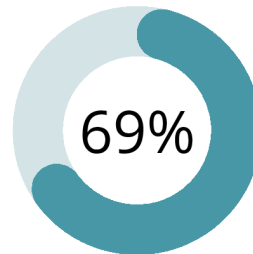
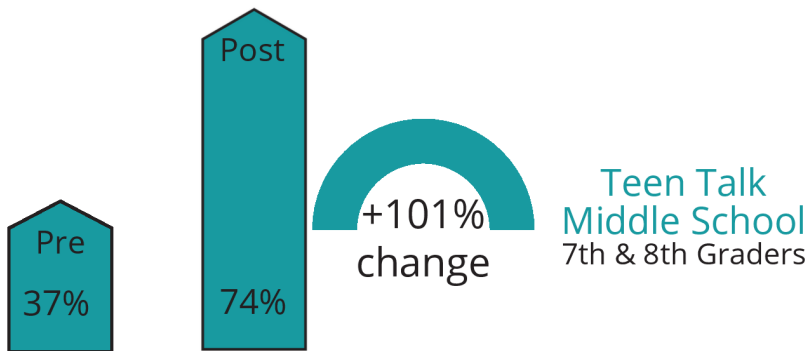
Change in Student Knowledge & Attitude by Course

Pre- & Post-Test Knowledge Change

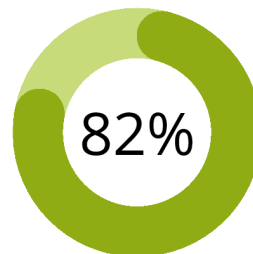
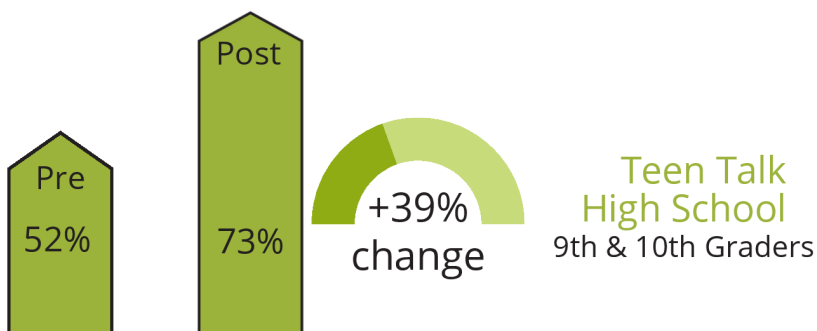
Post-Course Student Attitude



85% of students now feel more comfortable reporting inappropriate touching to a parent or trusted adult.



69% of students were able to identify at least one local clinic that provides free and confidential health services to teens.

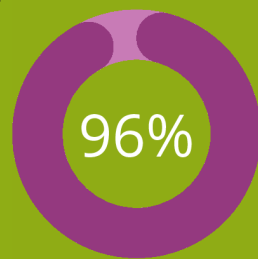


82% of students said they felt comfortable starting a conversation about their personal boundaries.

Our direct instruction courses earned a **World-Class (74)** Net Promoter Score from host classroom teachers.

PROVIDER SERVICES

We trained **577 teachers and youth providers** to deliver one or more of our effective sexual health and puberty health education curricula, serving an additional **31,549 students** across the United States.



96% of teachers and youth providers reported feeling more confident in delivering our curriculum to students after completing our training.

*Our curriculum implementation training earned an **Excellent (59)** Net Promoter Score from training recipients.*

We served a total of **2,822** people with our Parent Talk and Family Talk workshops, and information sessions.
