# Articles of Incorporation

-OF-

CANCER CARE SOCIETY, UNITED WAY

(Name of Corporation)

The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation, not for profit, under Sections 1702.01 et seq., Revised Code of Ohio, do hereby certify:

FIRST. The name of said corporation shall be CANCER CARE SOCIETY, UNITED WAY

SECOND. The place in Ohio where the principal office of the corporation is to be located is

300 W. Front Street, Findlay

Hancock

County.

(City, Village or Township)

THIRD. The purpose or purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

- (1). To promote and conduct programs for the continuing education and training of physicians, dentists, nurses, and other persons in the health service field as to all matters concerned with the detection, diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of cancer.
- (2). To promote and conduct programs for the continuing education of the public concerning cancer, its symptoms and detection, so as to further the timely use of medically and scientifically recognized means for the detection, diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of cancer.
- (3). To promote and establish programs of service to cancer patients.
- (4). To receive and maintain real or personal property, or both, and, subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter set forth, to use and apply the whole or any part of the income therefrom and the principal thereof exclusively for charitable, scientific, or educational purposes either directly or by contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.
- (5). No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any Trustee or Officer of the corporation, or any member of the corporation or any other private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes), and no Trustee or Officer of the corporation, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

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- (6). Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended, or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code and Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.
- (7). Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

FOURTH. Pursuant to Section 1702.08, Ohio Revised Code, the incorporation of Cancer Care Society, United Way, was authorized by a majority vote of the voting members present at a duly convened meeting the purpose of which was stated in the notice of the meeting.

FIFTH. The following persons, not less than three, shall serve said corporation as trustees until the first annual meeting or other meeting called to elect trustees.
