

O'Connor Animal Control and Adoption Center (the "TJO Shelter"), its successors or assigns, which is currently operated by the cities of Chicopee, Holyoke, and Springfield and the towns of West Springfield and Hampden pursuant to an Intermunicipal Agreement dated October 22, 2002, as it may from time to time be amended. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if, for any reason, the TJO Shelter does not continue in both the animal control and adoption businesses, the corporation may instead raise funds and provide financial support for the benefit of charitable organizations that provide for the care and adoption of stray or abandoned animals in western Massachusetts.
