The Learners Lab (TLL) is the nation's first charitable *Workforce Training & Fiscal Sponsorship Resource Center*. Our 501(c)(3) public non-profit status is sub chartered under the designation for entities engaged in job training, professional development, and other activities directed to individuals. As a charitable resource center, our mission is to eliminate training obstacles such as high cost, limited/restricted access to professional development or skill enhancement resources.

While **TLL's** primary service will be renting space and technology for workforce training, and hosting a virtual lab of software, a virtual library of training materials, we also serve as a Fiscal Sponsor supporting and providing technical assistance to pre-start-up and start-up tax exempt entities less than 2 years old.

Our work will include inspiring the return of Apprenticeships. **TLL** will lead by example by hosting both Interns (workforce trainees still in school) and Apprentices (workforce trainees not in school). Through our *Math, Science & Technology Center (MSTC)* we hope to introduce today's workforce and tomorrows learners to the broad technical careers using math and/or science with or to create technology. The MSTC is designed as a Corporate Partnership introducing a variety of careers, hosting networking center where hiring managers and job hunters meet, and an office hub for start-up tax exempts and TLL Fiscal Sponsorship who need office space, internet access and other resources.

TLL FISCAL PROGRAM

TLL's Fiscal Sponsorship is runs 6 months - 2-years, and in fairness to other applicants, renewals are not accepted. Our goal is to help every applicant, and TLL will accomplish that with the assistance of Mentor Partners..

Qualification Categories

Fiscal Sponsor opportunities are only granted for US entities pursuing or recently granted status as a US tax exempt entity (charity, nonprofit, foundation, association, other designation as defined by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS)).

- Category 1: Entities Pursuing Tax Exempt Status But Not Ready to File
- Category 2: Entities Ready to File for Tax Exempt Status But Requiring Additional Assistance
- Category 3: Entities With a F1023/1024 Application Pending Before the IRS
- Category 4: Approved 501s Needing Only Contribution Processing Services
