Eden Prairie Local News (EPLN) continues to mature from an all volunteer start-up created in 2020 to a developing community news source, with one full-time and three part-time employees (2.25 full time equivalents) including two co-editors and two reporters. They are complemented by freelancers and volunteers. EPLN's role is to be the primary source of non-partisan local news and special interest articles for people who live or work in, or are interested in, Eden Prairie. EPLN has grown its online subscriber base to 3,336, up 19% over the prior year. It published 1,112 articles and included 45 unique writers in year ended June 30, 2024. These stories, event calendar and related content were read via email or social media, or on the EPLN website, which had 1,353,015 page views, and increase of 11.4% over the previous year. These journalism efforts are supported by EPLN fundraising efforts.
