Dear Taxpayer,

Thank you for choosing John E. McGovern & Associates, P.C., a Certified Public Accounting firm, a/k/a/ CPAphilly.com to assist you with your 2024 taxes. This letter confirms the terms of our engagement with you and outlines the nature and extent of the services we will provide.

We will prepare your 2024 federal and state tax returns along with any local income tax returns, as requested. We will rely on you to provide the information we need to prepare complete and accurate returns. We may ask you to clarify some items but will not audit or otherwise verify the data you submit. An Organizer is available and will help you avoid overlooking important information. By using it, you will contribute to the efficient preparation of your returns.

We will perform accounting services only as needed and only upon request to prepare your tax returns. Our work will not include procedures to find defalcations or other irregularities. Accordingly, our engagement should not be relied upon to disclose errors, fraud, or other illegal acts, though it may be necessary for you to clarify some of the information you submit. We will inform you of any material errors, fraud, or other illegal acts we discover.

The law imposes penalties when taxpayers underestimate their tax liability or file returns late. Please contact us if you have concerns about such penalties. Taxing authorities may assess late filing, non-filing, and interest for returns filed and paid after the due date. Our firm's policy is not to request filing extensions unless the extension is requested by our clients, or if information needed to file is unavailable. If a client does not contact us and the return is due, we file a protective extension as a professional courtesy. An extension is only valid if its funded and 90% of the tax is paid. It is your responsibility to determine and fund extension tax payments.

Should we encounter instances of unclear tax law, or of potential conflicts in the interpretation of the law, we will discuss the reasonable courses of action and the risks and consequences of each. We will ultimately adopt, on your behalf, the alternative you select. Your returns are subject to review by the taxing authorities. Any items that may be resolved against you by the examining agents are subject to certain rights of appeal. In the event of an examination, we will be available upon request to represent you, or to review the results of any examination. Billing for these additional services will be at our standard rates.

Management is responsible for Client's compliance with the Corporate Transparency Act ("CTA"), if applicable to its business, and for ensuring that any required reporting of beneficial ownership information is timely filed with the Financial Crimes Enforcement Network ("FinCEN") as required by the CTA. As John E. McGovern & Associates, P.C., a Certified Public Accounting firm, a/k/a/ CPAphilly.com is not rendering any legal services as part of our engagement, we will not be responsible for advising you regarding the legal or regulatory aspects of your company's compliance with the CTA, nor are we responsible for the preparation or submission of Client's beneficial ownership

information reports to FinCEN. If you have any questions regarding Client's compliance with the CTA, including but not limited to whether an exemption may apply to your organization or to ascertain whether relationships constitute beneficial ownership under CTA rules, we strongly encourage you to consult with qualified legal counsel experienced in this area.

Our fee is based on our fee schedule and the complexity of the returns plus out-of-pocket expenses. Invoices are due and payable upon presentation. All accounts not paid within thirty (30) days are subject to interest charges to the extent permitted by state law. Any dispute within the engagement is limited to the fees paid to our firm for the engagement. We accept credit card payment.

We will return your original records to you at the end of this engagement. It is your responsibility to store these records, along with all supporting documents, canceled checks, etc., in a secure location in case these items are needed later to prove accuracy and completeness of a return selected for review by the tax authorities. We retain copies of your tax returns for seven years, after which these documents will be destroyed.

Our firm is required to electronically file all federal and state tax returns unless you notify us otherwise. If anything prevents you from qualifying for e-filing, you will be solely responsible to file the paper returns with the appropriate tax authorities. Our engagement to prepare your 2024 tax returns will conclude with the delivery of the completed returns to you (if paper-filing) or your signature and our subsequent submittal of your tax return (if e-filing). It is your responsibility to review all tax return documents for any errors or omissions carefully before signing. Any payments that are debited from your account should be verified by you in a timely manner.
