

## INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANT'S REVIEW REPORT

**Notes to the Financial Statements**

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**1. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies**

**Organization and Purpose** – Elmhurst Walk-In Assistance Network, Inc. (Organization) provides compassionate assistance to individuals and families in the Elmhurst, Illinois, community going through a difficult time. The Organization provides assistance with rent, utilities, car repair, prescriptions and gas as well as coordinating access to local food pantries and clothes closets, and fund essential dental care through partner dentists. The Organization also supports students in Elmhurst schools through the school snack program and the Students with Activity Needs fund ensuring students can participate in school programs.

**Method of Accounting** – The Organization’s financial statements are prepared on the cash basis of accounting, except for investments, which are stated at fair value. In doing so, balances and transactions are presented according to the existence or absence of donor-imposed restrictions as follows:

**Net Assets Without Donor Restrictions** – Net assets which are available for the fulfillment of the Organization’s mission and which may be expended at the discretion of management and the Board of Directors.

**Net Assets With Donor Restrictions** – Net assets which are subject to donor-imposed restrictions. Some restrictions could be temporary in nature, such as those that will be met by the actions of the Organization or the passage of time, while some restrictions could be perpetual in nature, in that the donor has stipulated the Organizations be maintained in perpetuity. Contributions received with donor restrictions that are met in the same year as received are reported as being received without donor restrictions.

Revenues are reported as increases in net assets without donor restrictions, unless use of the related assets is limited by donor-imposed restrictions. Expenses are reported as decreases in net assets without donor restrictions. Donor imposed restrictions are released when restrictions expire (i.e., the donor imposed stipulated purpose has been fulfilled or the stipulated time period has elapsed). Contributions are recognized as revenues in the period received.

The cash basis of accounting is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles. The cash basis of accounting differs from accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America, primarily as under the cash basis of accounting revenues are recognized when received rather than earned and expenses are recorded when paid rather than incurred.

**Investments** – Investments consist of all funds held in brokerage accounts and are accounted for at fair value with unrealized gains and losses reported in the statement of revenue and expenses. Fair value is defined as the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants as of a given measurement date. Such valuations are separated into a three-level hierarchy based on the reliability of observable and unobservable inputs as follows:

**Level 1** – Valuations are based on quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities that the Organization has the ability to access at the measurement date.

**Level 2** – Valuations are based on quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities in active markets, quoted prices for identical or similar assets or liabilities in markets that are not active, and model-derived valuations whose significant inputs are observable.

**Level 3** – Valuations are based on unobservable inputs for the asset or liability that reflect the Organization’s own data and assumptions that market participants would use in pricing the asset or liability.

**Functional Allocation of Expenses** – Costs of providing the various services and other activities have been summarized on a functional basis in the statement of activities and are detailed by their natural classification in the statement of functional expenses. Accordingly, certain costs have been allocated to and categorized as program services, management and general, and fund-raising expenses based on direct expenses or appropriate methods determined by management. These allocation methods include allocation of personnel and any other costs deemed to be related to time and efforts expended by employees on the different functional categories.

**Liquidity and Availability** – The Organization’s cash is available for general expenditure over the next year, that is without donor or other restrictions limiting its use.

**Income Taxes** – The Organization is a not-for-profit entity as described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and is exempt from income taxes, except for taxes on unrelated business income generated from unrelated or trade business activities. There was no unrelated business income for the year ended December 31, 2024. Accordingly, no provision for income tax is included in the financial statements. The Organization’s tax returns for the years ended December 31, 2021 through 2023, are open years for purposes of any future IRS or applicable state examinations.

**Subsequent Events** – Subsequent events have been evaluated through August 4, 2025, which was the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

**Net Assets With Donor Restrictions** – Net assets with donor restrictions generally consist of contributions that have an unexpired donor-imposed time restriction or a donor-imposed purpose restriction that has not been satisfied.

At December 31, 2024, net assets with donor restrictions that may be satisfied by the passage of time or by meeting donor-imposed purpose restrictions consists of the Carol Yesko Fund totaling \$21,218.

In 2024, the Organization received donations totaling \$21,000 to establish the Carol Yesko Fund. The principal of the Fund is to remain untouched for a period of 5 years. In 2029, the donor and the Organization will revisit the goals of the Fund and determine how the principal of the Fund should be used.
