The Bureau cannot approve the organization's registration until it pays its late filing fees. LATE FEES WILL ACCRUE AN ADDITIONAL \$25 ON DECEMBER 1, 2024, AND THE FIRST DAY OF EACH MONTH THEREAFTER.

Unless your current registration is still in effect, you cannot solicit contributions in Pennsylvania until all the reason(s) listed above are corrected. IF THE REGISTRATION WAS FILED USING THE ONLINE SYSTEM, THEN YOU CAN FILE THE REQUESTED MATERIALS ONLINE.

Please also note that charitable organizations have statutorily imposed due dates to complete their registrations. Organizations must pay a \$25 late fee for every calendar month (or part of a month) their registration is past due. These late fees are statutorily mandated and cannot be waived by the Bureau. Late fees will continue to accrue until a completed registration is received. If you correct the above deficiency(ies) immediately, your organizations registration can be completed, and ADDITIONAL fines and penalties avoided.
